The objective of the UEFA U21 European Championships Volunteer Programme is to plan and implement a meaningful, high quality, efficient and memorable programme across all venues. Around 300 volunteers will be required to assist with the delivery of the event's wide-ranging projects at venues in Budapest, Győr, Székesfehérvár and Szombathely.

The main mission of the Long-term Volunteers is to assist the LOS Volunteer Manager and LOS Venue Volunteer Managers in the promotion and recruitment campaign, mainly by leading interviews of candidates and selecting the most suitable volunteers that will ensure high-quality services during the event. Furthermore, they will provide assistance in the pre-event preparation phase, including important milestones like shifts scheduling and organisation of the kick-off training for all volunteers. The long-term volunteers will be given the opportunity to continue their mission in supporting the management of the other volunteers during the operational phase on-site.
